F.Y.I.

1. As you are aware we have had a mild start to winter. This has resulted in very low expenses dealing with winter, ie. salt, fuel, overtime, etc.
2. The highway department has committed to taking delivery of 2,800 ton of road salt prior to September 1, 2016. This is 70% of salt usage during the 2015-2016 winter season. To date, we have received approximately 940 ton of salt.
3. The skating rink will not be opening this year. Several holes were chewed in the tarp by mice during storage over the summer, and time did not allow for the purchase and delivery of a new tarp.
4. The mild winter has allowed highway crews to complete some drainage work for both the Town and the County. The continued attention to drainage along the roads helps to reduce flooding and protect the roads.
5. Highway personnel have also been trimming trees and brush along Town and County roads. Along with chain and pole saws, the highway department excavator (with mower) has been utilized.
