F.Y.I.

1. Harsher winter weather has returned to the Mendon area. Trucks have been out on numerous occasions to deal with snow and ice accumulations. We started the season with a full salt barn. Since the start of the "snow" season, we have had to add in excess of 1,700 ton of road salt. The increased activity is also reflected increased purchases of "magic" and fuel.
2. The skating rink was installed early, but seemed to take longer to ice over and become useful. The rink was opened but had to be closed to due to poor ice conditions. The rink was reopened on the 17<sup>th</sup>, and plenty of ice has formed due to the extremely cold weather.
3. After the holidays, and in between plow/salt runs, crews canvassed the Town for trees residents had set out. We try to pick up the trees on an "as available" basis. If we have the time available we pick them up, otherwise they wait for the spring pick up.
4. HFL has asked for a price for continuing the drainage work on Papermill Street. We have given them an estimated cost for the work, and are waiting for their response. The price is for materials plus the Towns cost for labor.
5. Highway crews have been improving the drainage on the east side of Plains Road between SR 251 and Junction Road. Approximately 650 feet of old drainage pipe was replace with larger pipe to improve the flow of large volumes of water. Four catch basins were also added. This should greatly reduce the flooding in the area during heavy rains.
