F.Y.I.

1. The ice rink at Semmel Road Park was installed December 21, 2011. The mild weather we have experienced has not been conducive to the formation of ice. When checked last Wednesday, only app. a ½ inch had formed.
2. We recently experienced a problem with a loss of power in Truck #93, a 2-year-old Volvo dump truck. The mechanics attempted to take the truck to the dealer, but the truck did not have enough power to climb the hill on Quaker Meeting House Road. They were able to get it back to the shop. The truck had to be transported to the dealer where repairs were made. The culprit: a heat sensor in the exhaust system. Repair cost: app. \$580.00. This type of problem may become more prevalent as the emission systems on the big trucks and heavy equipment gets more complex
3. With the lack of snow and ice, highway personnel have kept busy with trimming brush along Town roads, picking up Christmas trees, addressing some drainage problems, etc. The crew is also addressing a drainage pipe problem on West Bloomfield Road, south of Bulls Saw Mill Rd., for the County. The cost will be rolled into the W. Bloomfield Road project to be conducted this summer.
4. The Hamlet decorations have been removed for the winter and placed in storage at the Highway Department.
5. The Highway Department will be assisting HFL with a drainage project in the coming months, as time allows. The project is located off Papermill Street, Honeoye Falls.
