1. The Highway Department is in the process of prepping for winter. Salters are in the trucks awaiting calibration. We have app. 900 tons of salt in the barn and 4, 000 gallon of magic in the tank.
2. Dispatchers were started, today.
3. As of today, delineators are in place along the roads. All snow fence is in place, except the areas needing to be harvested. Those areas will fenced as soon as the fields are available.
4. Snow contracts still have not been received from the state, nor the county. They should be arriving shortly and will be forwarded to the Town board for approval.
5. The Town received minimal damage from Hurricane Sandy. A few trees and limbs were down. Those were cleaned up and brought back to the Highway Department.
6. Wednesday, the Highway Department will be recognizing Robert Keenan for 25 year service to the Town, and Robert Sherman for 30 years to the Town.
7. Pine trees were planted along Semmel Road, in the area of Driesbach Field. It is hoped that the trees will mitigate some of the concerns voiced by neighbors earlier in the year.
