

1. Highway crews have spent many hours on the roads plowing and applying salt. The last two storms have taxed our salt supply. We have come close to running out, but hope to have the salt barn filled by week's end.
2. The Highway Superintendent has postponed meeting with our elected State representatives this week. The superintendents try to meet with officials prior to the trip to Albany, but this was not possible due to medical reasons. The purpose of the meeting is to voice our concerns and enlist their support. Highway Superintendents will also meet with their representatives in Albany, the first week in March. Our local representatives' support is crucial to continued and/or increased CHIPS funding.
3. The cold weather has made for great ice skating conditions. Hockey is popular among a few of the rink users.
4. Prior to the recent storms, highway crews trimmed brush along town and county roads. This prevents the brush from encroaching the roadway, and keeps the from hitting our trucks.
5. Some of the roads are showing the signs of the cold weather. The freeze/thaw conditions create potholes or a breaking up of the roadways. The quick fix is to place cold patch in the holes and address the more severe areas in the spring with hot patch.
