

F.Y.I.

1. Word is that the City of Rochester has reevaluated the claim for work completed on Plains Road drainage and they will pay the claim. The claim was for Mendon Highway's drainage work that was necessitated because of the water main break on SR 251.
2. The mild weather has necessitated the closing of the ice rink. With no long periods of cold weather in the forecast, the rink, in all probability, will not reopen this season.
3. The milder weather, and lack of snow, has allowed the highway crews to do some tree trimming along Town and County roads. Where needed, we have also been doing a little drainage work.
4. The highway department has also replaced drainage pipe on the west side of Plains Road. This is unrelated to the water main break. The old metal pipe had deteriorated and was replaced with new plastic. The work will be completed, once the blacktop plant opens.
5. A large number of Highway Superintendents' from throughout New York traveled to Albany to plead the case for more funding for town roads. We were well received by the legislators we met with. How many dollars this will transfer to, will remain to be seen. The last few years, the Town of Mendon has received approximately \$56,000 in CHIPS funding.
6. 13 Hamlet banners were sent out for repair. The banners are showing their age and are more easily damaged by the elements. Their useful life is probably coming to an end. The banners will be re-installed prior to Memorial Day.
7. The floor drain at the west end of the main highway building was replaced. The original concrete and floor drains had deteriorated. A 4' x 63' section of concrete and floor drain was replaced.
