1. The "early" spring has allowed the Highway Department to get a jump on the clean up from winter. Snow fence is down, delineators are in the process of removal, and lawns are being repaired.
2. Asphalt prices are on the rise. Already the price has risen from \$55 a ton to \$61 a ton. This may have an effect on the roadwork planned for this summer.
3. The CHIPS program remains a question and is dependent upon the State's budgeting process. The main theme when the Highway Superintendents talk with legislators was how tight the money is.
4. We will be moving in to Dixon Woods to complete the clean up of the drainage area. We will be borrowing the mini excavator from Pittsford.
5. The Semmel Road ice rink is being drained. We had a couple good months of skating weather, but the rink has been close since late February.
6. Some snow and ice figures to ponder:
  - a. Highway crews drove approximately 43,900 miles,
  - b. Cost of this past season: app. \$377,000,
  - c. Salt used: app. 4,100 tons,
  - d. Man hours utilized: app.3,100
