1. The Highway Department has begun the spring brush pick up. Work started last Monday, May 6, 2013. On Tuesday, it was necessary to pick up brush along Cheese Factory Road due to the water line lawn restoration by the water authority. Getting the brush out of the way should provide a nicer finished product for the residents.
2. Curb and gutter repairs have been made along Assembly Drive. Hynes Concrete conducted Work; a Monroe County bid vendor. They repaired areas designated by the Highway Department.
3. Catch basins in Mendon Farms were also repaired and/or replaced by Sunshine Concrete, another vendor for Monroe County. 10 catch basins, as designated by the Highway Department, were repaired or replaced.
4. Highway Department crews finished up the drainage work on Plains Road.
5. Highway Department crews have addressed some drainage problems on Buggywhip Trail. This is part of the preparation for resurfacing (Motopave) work tentatively scheduled for June.
6. The two new pickup trucks, brush chipper, and used grader have been received. Highway personnel received training on the operation of the chipper.
7. Two employees, Andy Caschetta and Chad Whitney, attended a 1 day training course on surveying. The Cornell Local Roads Program presented this course.
