1. The highway crews completed the swing through Town picking up brush. Unfortunately, the high winds on Saturday, May 8, took down several limbs and trees. This occurred within a few days of completion of the normal pick up. A list of residents calling for additional help was compiled and crews were sent out last Wednesday to pick up the storm debris.

The quantity of brush placed at roadside did not appear to be as much as years past. This allowed crews to complete the pick up in app. 2 ½ weeks. The last few years have required app. 5 weeks to complete the task.

2. Roadside mowing started this past week. Again this year, the highway department will be cutting the grass along Town and County roads. The Town is reimbursed, on a seasonal basis, for the work on the County roads.
3. The highway department will be completing some prep work on County roads, preparing them for a surface treatment. The actual surface treatment is being held up by the lack of a State budget, and subsequent funding of CHIPS.
4. The new dump truck chassis is in Watertown awaiting installation of the box, plow and wing. The box, plow and wing have been built in Iowa by the contractor, Henderson, and will be in transit to Watertown this week.
