

1. The Highway Department completed the spring brush pick up on Wednesday, May 29th.
2. The spring equipment auction went well. The Town received \$48,249 as a result of the sale of the roadside mower equipment, 2011 Ford F150, and 2008 Chevrolet 3500.
3. Highway Department mechanics have been modifying the new "used" grader since its receipt. Last Monday, highway personnel started "wedging" Sheldon, Quaker Meeting House, and Taylor Roads. The grader performed very well and is a welcomed replaced for the old Galion grader.
4. The Highway Superintendents' training program at Cornell University went well with many very interesting topics discussed. The topics covered included moving work zones (such as when we pick up brush), legal issues presented by a panel of municipal attorneys, paving demonstration, etc. A schedule of training is attached.
5. The John Deere tractor has been taken the Lakeland Equipment, Avon, to be outfitted with the new roadside mower equipment. We hope to have it back soon, so the summer mowing program can begin in earnest. While the John Deere is away, some light roadside mowing have been conducted with the large Kubota tractor and rear mounted brush hog.
