F.Y.I.

1. The spring brush pick up continues. The arrival of the new excavator without a thumb put us behind, but the swing through Town should be completed this week.
2. As we had said last month, the break in brush pick up allowed the Highway Department to conduct some road work:
 - a. The southern half of Amann Road was resurfaced with a cold mix material. This is a CHIPS Project with funding from New York State. Rush Highway Department assisted. Later this year, this section will be stoned and oiled to tighten the blacktop.
 - b. Pond Road, from Douglas Road to SR 65 (Clover Street) was resurfaced. This is a Monroe County project. Rush Highway Dept. assisted with this project. As with Amann Road, Pond Road will receive a coating of stone and oil.
 - c. Mendon assisted Rush Highway Department with the resurfacing of #6 Road, another County project.
3. The old excavator was taken to Palmyra municipal auction and sold on May 12. We had hoped to receive \$20-25,000 for the unit, we are happy to report that the Town received \$60,000.
4. The Highway Department received a power surge during an electrical storm. The clerk's computer was damaged, along with some other electrical items. We are in touch with the insurance company to discuss possible damage reimbursement.
5. The Highway Department has begun the roadside mowing of Town and County roads. This will continue throughout the summer and into the fall.
