1. Truck #1 was sold at auction last month. The truck sold for \$25,500. The truck was 2 years old and had a little over 30,000 miles on the odometer. Original cost of the truck was \$22,267.59.
2. Attended the Highway School at Cornell last week. Very informative. One item stressed was to have plans, and to have those plans documented.
3. We have received the program for County roadwork. County roads receiving attention will be
Pittsford Mendon Center Road
Boughton Hill Road
Pond Road
Smith Road
West Bloomfield Road
West Main Street
Monroe County will expend app. \$576,000 on these roads.
4. Brush pick up went well this year. The highway crew moved around quickly and completed the work in less than 4 weeks. Funds should be available for the fall pick up.
5. Heavy rains pushed a lot of gravel out into Plains Road the night of April 27. Bob Keenan and Art Morrell responded to clean about 3"-4" of stone and mud with the backhoe and Kubota tractor/sweeper. The next day a highway crew redid the ditch and cleaned the pipe. Water appears to be flowing as it should and staying out of the road.
6. The roadwork on Braemar Way went well. The work on Huntington Heights didn't go so well. The condition of the road, dating back to it installation, force us to complete some drainage work prior to completion of the roadwork. We hope to have the work completed this week.
