F.Y.I.

1. The trucks and equipment declared as excess property were taken to Palmyra for auction. The auction took place on Saturday, May 14, 2016. The proceeds from the sale netted the Town \$90,077.50.
2. The highway department has taken delivery of the F-150, and it has been placed in service. Van Bortel Ford advises that the F-250 is being prepped and should be delivered at any time. Western Star dump truck has been received and should be pressed into service this week for roadwork.
3. As we said last meeting, the NY Dept. of Labor, Public Employees Safety and Health Division (PESH), paid an unannounced visit the Highway Department the third week in April. PESH inspected the buildings and equipment for safety concerns. While we have not received the formal report, the highway department continues to work on their concerns.
4. Tomorrow the highway department will start the surface treating (stone & oil) of Town and County roads. We have placed a list of the roads on our web site. Barring unforeseen circumstances or weather, we hope to have them completed by the end of Thursday. Rush Highway Department will be assisting, then the effort will turn to Rush with us assisting them. Once the stone and oil is in place on a road, we will try to note it on our web site.
5. Attended the highway superintendents' school in Ithaca last week. I was able to sit in on several good discussions with the DEC and other roadwork stakeholders. Several programs conducted by the highway department will be reviewed to bring them into current thinking and regulations.
