1. The Highway Department concluded the spring brush pick up on May 12, 2015. While the winter was very cold, it did not produce the usual high winds. This resulted in less brush at the roadside and reduction in time spent on the pick up.
2. The reduced time on brush pick up allowed us to get a jump on roadwork for both the Town and County.
3. The highway department received the "new" used roller from Stephenson Equipment. The roller, after personnel were trained, was put into use prepping Town and County roads for surface treat.
4. I attended the Highway Superintendents' school at Cornell last week. As always, the workshops conducted at the school are informative and deal with everyday issues confronting highway superintendents. You can view the agenda at clrp.cornell.edu.
5. Highway department personnel extended the water line from the Community Center building to the "Monroe County In Bloom" garden near the public sidewalk.
6. The sidewalk installation is nearing completion on SR 251, west of the Hamlet. The concrete is in place. Some minor construction and landscaping remains for the job to be completed.
