

F.Y.I.

1. The highway department took possession of the new Kenworth truck. Once the truck has been serviced by our mechanics, the truck will be placed in service. The replacement of our Volvo loader, under the equipment replacement plan, is anticipated in the next month or so.
2. The Town and Village experienced some high winds that resulted in a number of trees and limbs falling. The Highway Department assisted the Village with removal of some debris with labor and equipment. The Village indicated that they would reimburse the Town for the labor expenses, as they do with construction projects.
3. The Highway Department anticipates assisting residents with removal of their storm brush debris. After August 1, highway crews will target residents who have indicated they need assistance with removal of brush. A list of residents who have contacted the Highway Department will be used by the crew. It is not a general town-wide pick up. The regular fall pick up is anticipated to commence around October 1.
4. This week, 3 highway workers will be working with Honeoye Falls on their sewer project. The work will be conducted at night, starting around 7 PM. It is anticipated to last the entire week. The website for Honeoye Falls discusses the work in a little more detail.
5. The highway department has applied the surface treatment of stone & oil to roads scheduled for 2014. The work will be concluded once the County has striped the applicable roads and the work signage has been removed.
6. Quaker Meeting House Road has received its treatment of Nova Chip between Cheese Factory Road and SR 251. The same process has been applied to West Bloomfield Road, between Cheese Factory Road and SR 251. Where necessary the shoulders will be built up on both roads. Once the shoulder work is completed and the roads have been striped, the work signage will be removed.
