F.Y.I.

1. The Highway Department advertised the vacant MEO position and received numerous applications. A review of the applications resulted in the interviewing of 3 of the applicants. All three interviewed well and had acceptable backgrounds and experience. The process resulted in the hiring of Chad Whitney, a DPW worker for the Village. With Chad's experience, he should make a fine highway worker and employee for the Town. As with all employees, he will have a probationary period of one year.
2. NYS OGS has negotiated a new contract for salt for the 2012-2013 season. One important aspect of this new contract is that American Rock Salt has waived the storage fee for salt that was not taken under the 2011-2012 contract. This waiver is till the first of the year.
3. We have attached a projection of Monroe County roadwork and the monies billed to the County for the work. The most recent job to be completed was work on West Bloomfield Road in the Town of Pittsford. This does not include payments from the School, Village, or State.
4. A 1" overlay of blacktop was placed on Saddle Hill and Friends Lane last week. This finishes up major upgrades to the roads for 2012.
