F.Y.I.

1. The Highway Department will start the fall brush pickup on Monday, September 29, 2014. The date has been posted to the website and an ad will run in the Sentinel and Penny Saver.
2. Highway crews remain busy with roadwork. Last week Sycamore Ridge (Town) and Stoney Lonesome (county) were paved. Smith Road will receive a coat of stone and oil, between SR 64 and W. Bloomfield Road. Once shoulder and driveway work is completed, the job will be complete. Some Town and county roads will be prepped for surfacing next year.
3. The highway Department has begun preparing for the 2014-2015 winter season. Last Friday we received 138 ton of road salt. This was purchased under last years pricing, a savings of app. \$8.00 a ton. The State and county contracts should be received soon and will be forwarded to the Board for approval.
4. The drainage projects on Cole Road and Mendonshire Drive remain to be completed this year.
5. The Highway Department mechanic and myself will be traveling to Camp Drum next Wednesday to inspect a tanker truck. The tanker truck is is excess property with an original value of app. \$94,000. If the highway department decides to purchase, the cost to the Town will be \$3,500. The tanker will be used to assist in meeting DEC standards in disposing of waste water from the oil and water separator.
