

F.Y.I.

1. The Highway Department has set Monday, September 30, as the start date for the fall brush pick up.
2. Roadwork on Town roads is starting to wind down. Trout Creek was paved last week. Minor work remains, if time allows, before the brush pick up.
3. Roadwork on County roads is also winding down. The final coat of stone and oil was placed on Smith Road last Friday. Roads are being striped, signs removed, and bills submitted. Prep work remains to be completed on a few county roads, with those roads being resurfaced in 2014.
4. Monroe County is also in the process of removing all Ash trees from roads on which roadwork is being conducted. Many trees have been marked for removal by placing a white dot on the tree and a white line in the road. This is the result of the ash borer infesting numerous ash trees. A short message has been posted on the department's web site with a link to the County's information.
5. It's that time of the year. Approximately 650 ton of salt has been delivered, filling our storage facility to near capacity. Once the brush pick up is completed, preparations for winter's snow and ice will begin in earnest.
6. The old Galion grader was taken to the scrap yard. The best price was received from Weitsman at \$184.00/ton. Total money received was \$2,158.71.
