F.Y.I.

1. The Highway Department continues to pick up brush. We are in the third week of picking and hope to complete the work this week. Also, Green Renewable has been in grinding the brush on hand. The grinding was completed last Friday and they are in the process of trucking it out to their facility.
2. The tennis court installation is progressing. The contractor has started painting the surface. Weather permitting, they hope to complete the painting this week. Once the painting is completed the fence will be lowered. This should complete the installation process.
3. Truck #2, the Ford 550 pick up truck has finally arrived. This is the truck with the plow and salter that is used for small areas and parking lots. The tilt bed is also utilized in the summer for hauling small loads.
4. Along with other municipalities in the area, we are looking for a means for disposing of dead deer carcasses picked up along the road. A few months back, Baker Commodities stopped taking the carcasses. The county is also looking into the problem. The landfills appear to be the best option, but the pricing details are still being worked on.
5. The salt barn needs to have the apron paved and the electric installed. We hope to complete this once the brush pick up is completed. The barn will be ready to receive salt.
6. The holding tank for the oil and water separator has been installed and connected to the separator. We have requested a hauling permit from NYS DEC for the hauling to Canandaigua. This will bring us into full compliance with the DEC regulations.
7. We still have County road work to complete on Brooks Road (Henrietta), Willard Road (Pittsford) and Boughton Hill. This consists mostly of drainage and grading work.
8. We still have some tree and drainage work to complete along town roads. The work will be conducted as time allows.
