



F.Y.I.

1. The Highway Department started the Fall brush pick up as scheduled, Monday, October 2, 2017. It appears that the amount of brush put to the "curb" is consistent with previous fall pick ups. The area to the east of West Bloomfield Road was completed in about 4.5 days.
2. The Highway Department completed work on Carolina Drive. Damaged curb and gutter was removed and then replaced by a contractor. Sections of the road were milled and filled. It is anticipated that this road will be dedicated to the Town in the near future. Expenses for the work are being charged to the developers letter of credit.
3. Work continues on Boughton Hill Road for Monroe County DOT. Work mainly consists of ditching and installation of drain pipe in preparation for resurfacing during 2018.
4. The County also requested that 5 manholes be raised on West Main Street as a part of that resurfacing. This was completed and the manholes are nearly level with the pavement surface, providing a smoother ride for motorists.
5. The County has also requested our assistance with repair of some catch basins on Calkins Road (Henrietta) and the reshaping of the shoulder on Honeoye Falls #6 Road, west of SR15A. We anticipate completing this work in the next few weeks, along with the continued work on Boughton Hill Road.
6. The Highway Department also anticipates start of the site work for the new salt facility, as time allows. This will include the removal of soil and replacing/compacting stone that will provide the base of the blacktop floor.
