F.Y.I.

1. The Town's skating rink at Semmel Road Park has been closed. The run of warm weather a few week ago melted all the ice. The weather probably will not get cold enough to refreeze the ice for the remainder of the season. We will be removing the rink as soon as weather and workload permits.
2. I traveled to Albany for "Advocacy Day" this past Tuesday. That evening the event was canceled due to the predicted snow storm on Wednesday. Just about everyone was trying to get out of Albany before the storm.
3. Local highway superintendents have been able to meet with local legislators in the Monroe County area. I discussed possible funding with both Senator Funke and Assemblyman Errigo.
4. Catch basins on Bosworth Field and Windham Hill were repaired along with installation of pipe. The catch basin and pipe on Windham Hill apparently were never connected at the time of construction, with the pipe being about 2 feet short of the catch basin.
5. 4 large dead trees were removed from the cemetery on Rt. 251, west of Sheldon Road. These were both a safety hazard and could potentially damage headstones should they come down on their own.
6. With the approval of the Town Board, we anticipate a contractor remove several dead trees on Taylor Road. The pricing for this is under Monroe County bid pricing.
