1. Mother Nature has not been very accommodating in the provision of cold weather for the ice rink at Semmel Road Park. Availability for skating has been very limited and prospect do not look good for the remainder of this season.
2. The highway department has tentatively set Monday, April 24, for the start of the spring brush pick up. This, of course, is contingent upon winter conditions and the ability to break down our large trucks.
3. Last Tuesday the area received another blast of high winds. The Town did not receive much damage to Town property and right of ways along the roads. It appeared that much of the high winds were to the north of the Town. Another mitigating factor was that the Town has had a policy of tree trimming and removal of dead and dangerous trees along Town roads.
4. The Highway Superintendent attended "Advocacy Day" in Albany, along with about 700 other highway superintendents and persons concerned with the maintenance of roads. After discussions with our state legislators, it was felt there may be a good chance for increased funding for Town roads. We won't know for sure until the State budget is passed.
