F.Y.I.

1. We anticipate the start of the Spring brush pick-up to commence Monday, April 30, 2018. This has been posted on our website and published in the Sentinel and Penny Saver.
2. The highway department is in the process of closing out the winter season. Delineators and snow fence have been removed. The skating rink is being drained and the tarp will be removed shortly. Lawn repairs, sweeping of the roads, and picking up of debris along Town roads remains to be done.
3. Highway Superintendents met with the County to discuss the roadwork to be conducted on county roads this summer. We have posted the listing of work in Mendon on our website.
4. All members of the highway department have attended a class on harassment conducted by Educational Resource Associates, our employee assistance program contractor. Personnel also attended a short discussion on the new testing requirements relative to their CDL licenses.
5. Highway personnel prepared the pad for the new salt storage facility and it is ready for the next phase of construction.
6. In the last issue of the "*Town Topics*", there was an article on the new regulations issued by the DEC relative to the storage/disposal of debris and waste material. The Monroe County Highway Superintendents Association scheduled a meeting with DEC personnel from both Avon and Albany on the subject.
7. The Highway Department evaluated new radios. This included mobile radios in vehicles, handheld portable radio, and base station radio. This evaluation was conducted along with Rush Highway Department. The new system worked well and no "dead" spots were noted. We are looking for funding for the new equipment.
8. Work continues on upgrading the oil/water system at the highway department. Waste water samples have been taken to a testing lab and we are awaiting the results. Honeoye Falls advises they would be unable to take the waste water. Our next best bet is to haul to Canandaigua, if the results permit.
9. Last Wednesday, the bids were opened for a new "driveway" roller. The results, along with our recommendation is on the agenda.

10. I met with Town Board Member Mike Roberts relative to the Hamlet flowers, banners, and decorations. The current decorations are showing there many years of use and it is hoped they can be upgraded.
