F.Y.I.

1. New York's budget passed, after a short delay. As a result of the passage, Mendon will receive CHIPS funding in the amount of \$139,890.54, PAVE-NY funding in the amount of \$15,966.30, and EXTREME WEATHER funding in the amount of \$12,322.54. It should be noted that the CHIPS funding includes last year's funds, since it was not expended.
2. All highway department employees, along with several from the Town Hall, attended Jim Parker's presentation on Workplace Violence and employee relations. Annual training on workplace violence is mandated by the NYS Department of Labor. Jim is associated with Educational Resources Associates. This is the company that is contracted to oversee the CDL drug/alcohol testing of drivers and provides employee counseling services.
3. Highway department employees commenced the spring brush pick up on April 24, and is progressing well. On Wednesday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>, all brush had been picked up east of West Bloomfield Road.
4. Today, mechanics transported the International dump truck and other excess property items to Palmyra to be sold at the Municipal Auction this Saturday.
5. Hynes Concrete began the process of removing the curb/gutter along Assembly Drive. They will then replace the curb/gutter. Once the installation is complete, the highway department will bring the blacktop to the newly poured curb/gutter.
6. Suit-Kote will be resurfacing West Main Street from the 4 Corners to the Village limits next week for Monroe County. The highway department completed some minor prep work by milling some poor spots and replacing the blacktop. The entire resurfacing project will be handled by Suit-Kote.
