F.Y.I.

1. Tennyson Way was milled and filled (paved) on June 4, 5 and 6. This maintenance allow the restoration of the crown in the road and provide better drainage.
2. Attended the Highway School June 4-6. This takes place at Cornell University and is sponsored by the Cornell Local Roads Program and the state associations for New York highway superintendents. While the programs concentrate on road and drainage issues, discussions are also held on legal and other issues facing towns and highway departments.
3. Work was completed on High Country Trail, Top Spin Drive, and Parrish Road (Lanning Road east to town line). This was a cold mix pave application where the materials are mixed at the highway department and transported to the job site. The work is done through Suit-Kote. Rush Highway Department assisted us with the hauling of material. In addition, these roads received a treatment of stone and oil.
4. Work was also completed on Mill Street, all roads in Mendon Farms, Partridge Hill, Partridge Hollow, Lanning Road, Harloff Road and Rush-Mendon Town Line Road. These roads received a treatment of stone and oil.
5. Boughton Hill Road, a County road, also was stoned and oiled between West Bloomfield Road and the Monroe County line. Rush, who assisted, and Mendon will be reimbursed for the expenses.
6. The new phone system for the Highway Department is in the process of being installed. This was purchased through Frontier and will replace the app. 30 year old system currently in use. Installation should be completed in the next day or two.
7. Contract work has started on the new salt storage facility. Material was delivered on 7-6-18, and work commenced on the 7-9-18. The work is progressing well, and should be completed around the end of the month. Once the contractual work is completed, we will blacktop the floor, install lighting, and perform a little landscaping.
