

F.Y.I.

1. Portions of Boughton Hill and Cheese Factory Roads; and the entire length of Williams Road have been surface treated with stone and oil. These are County Roads for which the Town expenses will be reimbursed. The roads are awaiting center striping and sign removal.
2. Town roads: Plains, Sheldon, Lyons (town portion) and Taylor (Mile Square to Victor Line) have also been surface treated. Once striped, the signs will be removed.
3. The following roads were surface treated: Windham Hills and Circle, Oakberry, Chateau, Hawks View, Owls Rest, Woodspring Hill, and Country Meadow were also surface treated. In addition they were "slurry sealed". This process was completed, today. Signs are in the process of being removed.
4. Rush Highway Department personnel assisted with the surface treat of Mendon and County roads, as did Mendon Highway personnel with Rush and County roads.
5. Last Thursday the Town received some heavy rain showers that caused the flooding of several roads. Warning signs and cones were put in place, but no roads had to be closed to traffic. By 8:00 PM, the water had receded from all roads. Cones were set to the side of the roads and picked up Friday, along with the warning signs.
6. Partridge Hill and Hollow have been prepped for resurfacing by the "cold in place paving" process. This work, originally scheduled for July 24th has been pushed back to August 2, due to the rainy weather.
7. Highway personnel are assisting the Village of Honeoye Falls with the mill and fill resurfacing of Church Street and Hyde Park. This work started today and will end Friday, is the schedule is not affected by weather.
