

F.Y.I.

1. Partridge Hill and Partridge Hollow were resurfaced using a "cold mix pave" process. In a few weeks the roads will receive a chip seal treatment. A follow up treatment of chip seal will be completed next summer.
2. Highway personnel continue to work on Boughton Hill Road between West Bloomfield Road and the Victor town line. Monroe County has allocated approximately \$200,000 for this work. Next year additional funds should be allocated to resurfacing of the road. This year's preparation addresses drainage and road surface problems.
3. A resident of Langpap Road had a concern with the speeds of vehicular traffic. The Highway Department set up the speed monitor on the road for 4 days, 2 days in each direction. The posted speed limit is 30 mph. It was found that 71.8% of the traffic was traveling at a speed of 30 mph, or less, and that 99.3% of the traffic was at 40 mph, or less.
4. This past Thursday and Friday, we sent 4 trucks and drivers to Perinton to assist with the micro-paving of Ayrault Road. Monroe County will reimburse the Town for the cost of the vehicles and drivers.
5. As a prelude to the 2018 Budget, we have begun to look at the conditions of Town roads. We will put together a program, including costs, to be included in next year's budget.
6. The new 6-wheel dump truck, along with the plow and wing, has arrived and will be prepared for service by our mechanics.
