F.Y.I.

1. The contractors completed their work on the new salt facility. Town crews have placed stone inside in preparation of paving. Crews have also placed stone and millings beneath the lean-to portion in anticipation of storing equipment.
2. The tennis court is progressing slowly. The sleeves for the nets have been put in place. New York fence is next up install the posts for the perimeter fencing. Once that is completed the topcoat of blacktop will be layed. Fence will be installed and then the painted court top. Hopefully the work will be completed this year, but may run into early 2019.
3. Winter is approaching. We have ordered 600 ton of salt under 2017-2018 pricing. The base price of salt has increased for the 2018-2019 winter season.
4. The fall brush pick up will be started on Monday, October 1, 2018.
5. Highway personnel paved the approaches for to the culverts what had been replaced on West Bloomfield road. The County completed their work and the road was opened on Friday, August 31<sup>st</sup>.
6. Highway personnel were at 15 Monroe Street (the old library) for a few days removing accumulated material from the basement and placing in a dumpster. That work has been completed.
