March 7, 1935.

Meeting of the Town Board of Mendon held in Grange Hall in the village of Mendon on March 7 1935 at 8 P.M. called to order by the Supervisor with the following members present.

Justices Swift, Martini + Deen, Supervisor Buckland and Clerk Prude

Several residents and taxpayers of the proposed fire district were present and questions were asked and answered by the Board.

Where as - a petition having been duly filed with the Town Board of Mendon on the 7th day of January 1935 asking for the establishment of a Fire District in Mendon in accordance with maps + plans filed in the Town Clerk's office, and purporting to be signed and acknowledged by a majority of the owners of the taxable real property within the proposed district herein described.

Where as - The Town Board of Mendon in accordance with sections 170 + 171 of the Town Law duly posted notices as required by Law for a Public Hearing to be held at Grange Hall, Mendon on the 7th day of March 1935 at 8 o'clock P.M. to consider said petition and to determine whether it is in the public interest to grant the relief sought, and whether all property or property owners benefited are included therein.

No objections having been offered on the part of any property owner included in said District and that the owners of property in

said District are benefitted thereby, We the Town Board of Mendon approve of the boundaries of such district as filed.

The following resolution was offered by Justice Dunn seconded by Justice Quick and upon motion was duly passed.

Resolved - That the creation of a Fire District as asked for under said petition is for the public interest and that the owners of property included in the district are benefitted thereby and that we approve of the boundaries of said district as shown on map filed.

The following resolution was offered by Justice Dunn, seconded by Justice Quick and upon motion was adopted.

Resolved - That the following residents of Mendon Fire District #1 be appointed as Officers of the Fire District to hold office until December 31, 1935.

For Fire Commissioners - George McNeil, Edward Zuber, George Schuth, W. D. Fletcher and Orrin Halford.

For Treasurer - Wallace Habecker.
