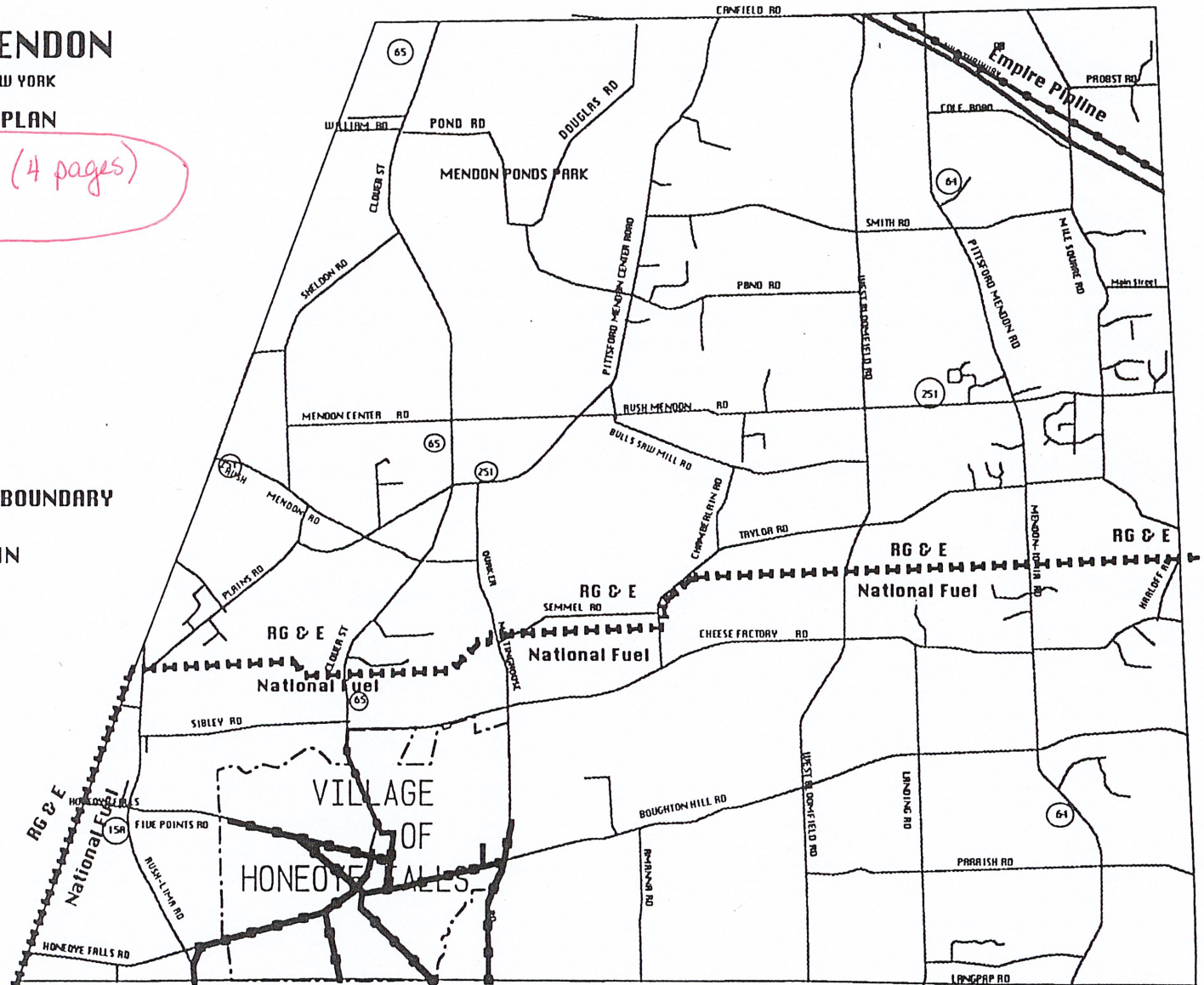
NATURAL GAS

To Fire Chief / Police Chief / Sheriff:

Empire State Pipeline would like to share the following information with you regarding what action should be taken if a natural gas leak or rupture occurs involving Empire State Pipeline facilities. Please know that Empire's fundamental concern during any pipeline emergency is implementing immediate action to protect people first, followed by appropriate action to protect property.

Here are some potential situations we may encounter:

1. If your agency is ever contacted by anyone other than an Empire employee regarding an emergency involving our facilities, please place a collect call to:

2. If your agency arrives at the emergency site before Empire employees, we request that you follow the guidelines listed below...

- * If the pipeline or pipeline facility is on fire, DO NOT FIGHT THE FIRE! Maintain a safe distance from the pipeline or pipeline facility; do not enter any pipeline facility until Empire personnel are on site.
- * Evacuation of the area may be necessary depending upon the intensity of the leak or fire. Start the evacuation downwind of the emergency site, increasing the area around the site until a minimum zone of 1/2 mile around the site is evacuated.
- * Keep sightseers away and restrict or re-route traffic away from the emergency site.
- * Establish communications between other law enforcement agencies, fire departments, and other emergency response departments.
- * If the escaping gas is not burning, take steps to prevent ignition. This should include prohibiting smoking, rerouting traffic, and shutting off any ignition source.
- * Do not attempt to operate any of the valves on the pipeline. Improper operation of the pipeline valves could make the situation worse and cause other accidents to occur. Valves will be operated only by Empire personnel.
